Summer Distance Studies & Summer Evening:

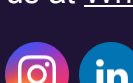
- **June 8:** Last day to withdraw from a 6-week first-term course resulting in a grade of 'WDN.' Course withdrawals after this date will appear on a transcript with a grade of 'F'
- **June 19:** Last day to add or drop a 6-week second-term course. Courses dropped by this date will not appear on a transcript. Courses dropped after this date will appear on a transcript with a grade of 'WDN' (withdrawn, without academic penalty)

Intersession:

- **June 2:** Last day to add or drop a 3-week second-term course. Courses dropped by this date will not appear on a transcript. Courses dropped after this date will appear on a transcript with a grade of 'WDN' (withdrawn, without academic penalty)
- **June 15:** Last day to withdraw from a 6-week course resulting in a grade of 'WDN' (withdrawn, without academic penalty). Course withdrawals after this date will appear on a transcript with a grade of 'F'
- **June 16:** Last day to withdraw from a 3-week second-term course resulting in a grade of 'WDN' (withdrawn, without academic penalty). Course withdrawals after this date will appear on a transcript with a grade of 'F'
- **June 22:** Examinations begin
